Absences

We cannot emphasise too strongly the importance of regular attendance. If your child is unable to attend Nursery for any reason, please ensure that the school is informed either by email, letter or by phone. We have a central e-mail account for you to use: absent@st-michaels.surrey.sch.uk Please make sure you give your child's name and class in the 'subject box' and the reason for the absence in the message. This will be passed on to your child's teacher.

Homework

There is a Nursery Library box in the Nursery entrance porch please borrow a book and read it to your child and return it when you have finished you are welcome to borrow as many books as you like.

School Uniform

All children are required to wear the Nursery uniform, the yellow polo shirt and the green jumper, alongside appropriate footwear. Only the official green draw string school bags should be brought into school.

Please ensure that every item of clothing brought to school is clearly labelled with your child's name including their water bottles.

Please note that sports socks (trainer socks), nail varnish, colourful hair bands, jewellery and **hair product of any kind** are not a valid part of the school uniform. **Boys should not have tram lines shaved into their hair.** Boys are not permitted to wear earrings, girls may do so but they must be **small, plain metal studs.**

Equipment

May we remind you that children are **not allowed to bring in any of their own equipment** including pencil cases, pencils, rubbers etc.

Packed Lunches

We would like your co-operation with helping us to promote a healthy lifestyle within our school by ensuring that your child's packed lunch contains snacks of a nutritious nature and limiting chocolate and crisps. **Could we request that you keep the children's packed lunch boxes free from nuts.**
