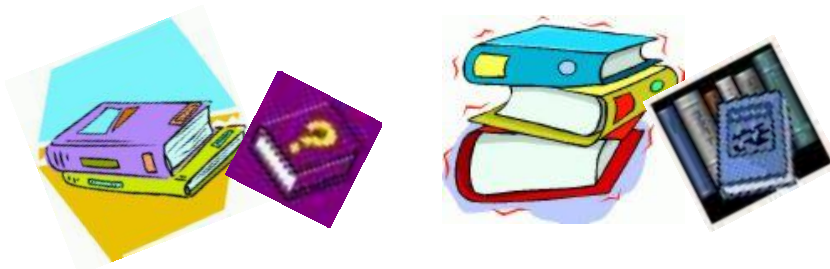




Book Challenge:

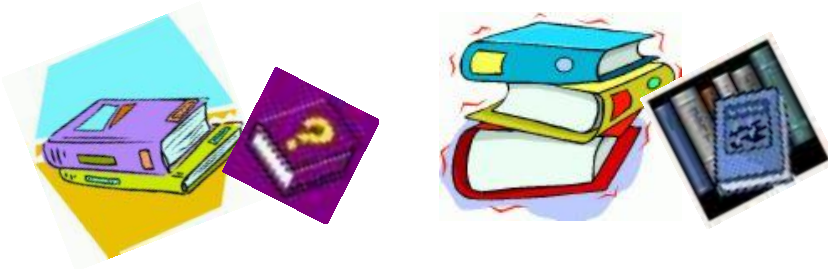
Look at the front cover of your book. Think about what the story could be about just by looking at the front cover. Write a new short story which could have the same front cover



Book Challenge:

Change the ending to your book! Think about what might have happened if something different had happened to the

characters! Write a short alternative ending to your book.



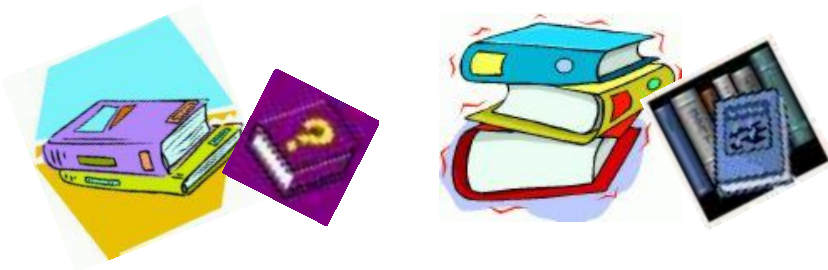
Book Challenge:

Read the book through. Think about the characters from the book and their feelings at different points in the story. Act out the story from the book thinking about how the characters are feeling and changing your voice to match their feelings. Try to use lots of expression!



Book Challenge:

Read your book to your younger brother, sister, cousin or neighbour without any help.



Book Challenge:

Read your book. Look for any words which rhyme. Think of a title for your rhyme and use the words to write a short rhyme!



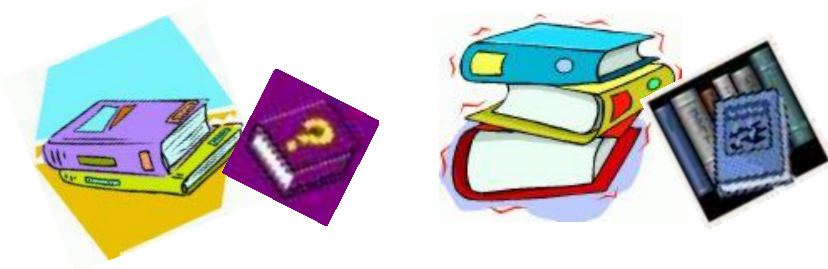
Book Challenge:

Copy some sentences from the book onto pieces of paper. Put them in a hat and shake them up. Close the book. Pick a sentence out of the hat and open the book. Match up the sentences.



Book Challenge:

Have you learnt any new words whilst reading your book? Write them on to pieces of card twice and find a friend to play Word Snap! with.



Book Challenge:

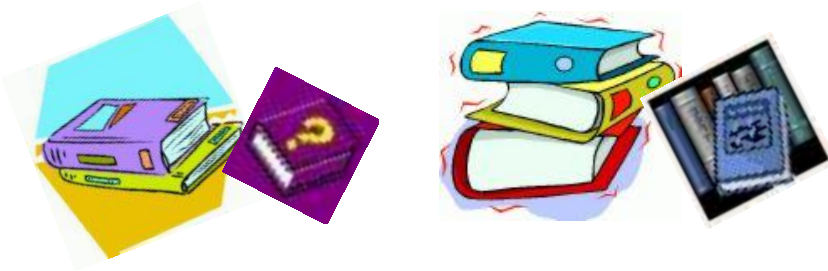
Read your book. Think about the characters or animals in your book.

Write a set of questions you would ask the characters if you could interview them.



Book Challenge:

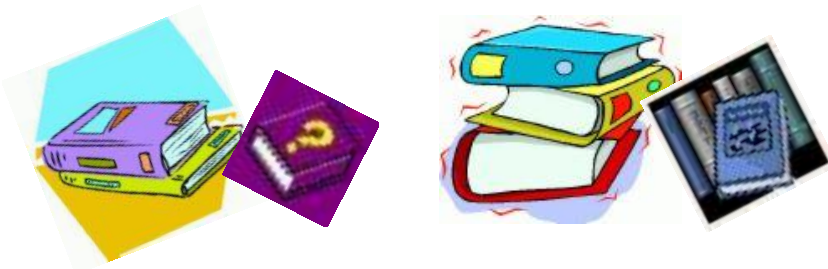
Hide parts of words, sentences or whole paragraphs and try to guess the rest of the word, sentence or paragraph by looking at the pictures or thinking about what parts of the book you have already read!



Book Challenge:

Before you read the book put it into a clear envelope and seal it. Look at the front cover of the book and from the pictures try to guess what the book might be about. Do not read the Blurb on the back page. Think about your ideas and what you know from the front cover of the book and write a short Blurb for the book. After you have written your Blurb turn the book over and see if it was the same. Then read

your book and see if it was about what you thought it was about!



Book Challenge:

Before you read your book put it into a clear envelope and seal it. Look at the front cover of the book and from the pictures write a short story about what you think the book is about. After you have written your story open the envelope, read the book and see if they were the same!
