The Governors intend to admit up to 92 children arranged as set out in the tables below.

1. Parents will be asked to give a preference for Option 1 or Option 2. On the application form, parents may also wish to express an interest for an additional 15 hours (full time place) subject to availability.
2. Account will be taken of any preferences expressed by parents but places will be allocated subject to availability and are not guaranteed. If the preferred option is unavailable, an alternative place may be offered.

Full Time Option

3. Within each oversubscription category, places will be allocated to Options 1 and 2 in the first instance. If places are still available in either option, in the equivalent age range, places will then be offered to applicants who would like to be considered for an additional 15 hours (full time place) and are able to provide an eligibility code.
