What is it? Why are we offering it?

Here at St Michael's we aim to promote safe and sustainable travel.

This year, children have been taking part in the WOW walk to school challenge through the charity Living Streets. Children have already earned many badges for travelling sustainably, mostly through walking, park and stride and the use of scooters. However, we have noticed that bikes along and safety equipment are rarely used.

We have therefore created the Travel Safe Library with a funding grant that was awarded to us from Sustrans – a charity that promotes safe and active travel. With this grant we have been able to get 12 bikes and enough safety equipment for 30 children!

These bikes and safety equipment will be available for rental throughout the school year and school holidays. Need a bike and/or safety equipment for a UK holiday? Rent from us free of charge!

Travel Library Loan Times

Pick up Friday afternoon between 3-3:30pm from the playground

Return Monday morning to the playground 8:30-9am

You can borrow a bike for a full week, a weekend, Monday to Friday or even for a whole school holiday!

To express interest in borrowing a bike and all of the safety accessories (helmet, high vis, knee pads and D lock), you MUST complete an online form at least a week in advance and wait for confirmation from Miss Fright.
