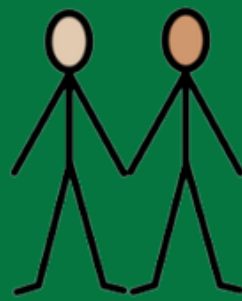

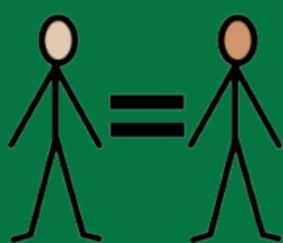

Creation

W h a t w i l l w e l e a r n ?

Revisit and remember the first Creation story from Genesis, recognising the author’s use of poetic language to describe how the world was formed.	
Encounter the belief that human beings are made ‘in the image of God’ (Gen 1:27) and talk about what this might mean. (RVE)	
Make simple links between the first Creation story, the belief that all human beings are created equal, and an expression of the principle of Catholic Social Teaching about human dignity. (RVE)	
Describe stewardship by making simple links between Genesis 1:26-31 and people’s actions today (LS 88 on ‘ecological virtues’). (RVE)	
Using some religious vocabulary, describe how either a psalm or a prayer they have studied praises Creation.	
Recognise that in Laudato Si’, Pope Francis teaches that human beings are called to have a loving relationship with God, with each other, and with the world (see LS 66). (RVE)
