What will we learn?

Make links between the Ten Commandments and Jesus’ summary of the law in Matthew’s Gospel (22:36-40).	
Correctly use developing specialist vocabulary to describe what a covenant is, recognising that God made several covenants throughout history, e.g., with Noah, Abraham, and Moses.	
Use developing specialist vocabulary to show how the Ten Commandments help human beings live good and happy lives.	
Correctly use developing specialist vocabulary to describe sin as deliberately spoiling our friendship with God and each other.	
Know that a virtue is a positive habit that helps people live a good life. (RVE)
